

## PBRP SPRING NEW MONITORS' WORKSHOP

Come learn from our volunteers! You will hear basic Western Bluebird facts, where bluebirds live and their nesting habits, and where and how we do our conservation work. Volunteers will talk about and demonstrate the basics of bluebird monitoring and explain how our project is structured and where monitors fit into the program. You will understand monitor responsibilities and time commitments so that you will have information to help you decide if your interests and available volunteer time would be a good fit with our activities. Active volunteers in our program will be there to help answer your individual questions. We assign new monitors to routes that are vacated by retiring volunteers. We anticipate a good number of vacancies in the 2010 nesting season (April through August).

Routes are primarily in the Dundee, Newberg, Sherwood, Wilsonville, Oregon City, Beaverton/Hillsboro, and West Linn areas.
